## **ABOUT THE FACILITY**

### **Arenas & Footing**

Two competition arenas and one warm-up arena, all 20m x 60m with dirt/woodwaste footing. All arenas are covered.

### **Camping on grounds**

\$35/night, no tents permitted. Electrical hook-ups available. All vehicles (including trailers) using RV spaces must pay fee and have "PAID" camping card in vehicle window at show.

### **Food**

Concessions on grounds.

### **Stabling**

Full door, 10'x10' box stalls on grounds (includes initial bedding). Additional bedding may be purchased on grounds. Haul-in fee for horses not stabled. Contact Ed Miller (541) 482-2902 or eamgroup@aol.com if you are arriving before Friday.

## **AWARDS**

Classes will be split into Open, Adult Amateur and/or Junior/Young Rider when 3 or more in a division. Ribbons through fifth place; awards to first place except in classes with fewer than three entries. Some undersubscribed classes of same test and/or level may be combined for award purposes. Class 223 will be the USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal class. See page R-10 for eligibility requirements. High point awards will be given. Julie Lile Memorial Trophy awarded to adult amateur with highest average score over two different tests.

## **DIRECTIONS**

Take I-5 to Central Point exit (#33). If coming from the north, take a left after taking exit, turn left at the second light onto Penniger Road, then turn right at livestock gate #5. If coming from the south, turn right after taking the exit, immediately get in left lane, turn left at the light onto Penniger Road, and turn right at livestock gate #5.
